**Recycling Guide for Recycling Bin**

Plastics, Metal, Glass and Cardboard in Red Container.

**Plastics:** Plastic bottle and dish containers with the recycle emblem #1 – 7 on bottom.  
Containers washed clean and co-mingled in container.

**Metal:** Tin and aluminum food and beverage cans.  
Containers washed clean and co-mingled in container.

**Glass:** Clear, brown, blue and green bottles and jars, (food and beverage ONLY)  
All glass must be washed clean and co-mingled in container.

**Cardboard:** Corrugated & chip-board cardboard.  
All cardboard must be flattened.

**Paper:** Newspaper, Magazines, phonebooks, junk-mail, computer paper, envelopes,  
Paperback books and hardbound books.

**EXAMPLE OF ITEMS THAT ARE NOT RECYCLABLE**

Styrofoam products, Styrofoam egg cartons, plastic bags – toys, broken glass,  
window or mirror glass, tissue paper, wax paper, wrapping paper, cardboard not broken down,  
paper plates, hangers, bubble wrap, toxic oil containers.

**ALL RECYCLABLES MUST BE CLEAN!!!!!!**

**GARBAGE RULES & REGULATIONS**

Johnson County Refuse Inc provides weekly curbside garbage and recycling pickup. Pickup will be on Tuesday. Johnson County Refuse Inc uses a “Sticker System”, you will be able to use up to a 35-gallon bag or can capacity. (No cans larger than 35 gallons will be accepted)

Stickers may be purchased at BP  
City Hall

**Garbage** will need to have garbage stickers placed according to size  
(\$1.25 per sticker)

\*Bags and or cans up to 20 gallon will require one (1) sticker

\*Bags and or cans 21 to 35 gallon will require two (2) stickers

When setting garbage out in cans, you may put the sticker or stickers to the top of the garbage or wrap the sticker or stickers around can handle once and stick ends together. Cans to be filled level full only not heaped up. When setting garbage out in bags, wrap sticker or stickers around bag tie and stick ends together. There is a 40# weight limit on all garbage.
