

**POLICY 2008 – 2
CITY OF LONE TREE
TREE LIMB PICKUP
RULES AND REGULATIONS**

The purpose of the Tree Limb Pickup rules and regulations policy is to establish and maintain uniform procedures concerning tree limb pickup in a safe and cost-effective manner, taking into account, safety, budget, personnel, and environmental concerns.

This policy does not guarantee that yards will be free of Tree Limbs after the execution of the Tree Limb pickup.

Operators must have a valid State of Iowa driver's license. An application with a copy of current driver's license shall be on file with the City Clerk before employment begins.

Tree Limb Pickup (March – November):

Tree Limbs will be picked up every Third Monday of the month. Tree Limbs must be set at the roads edge (not in the street) by 7a.m. NO ALLEY PICKUP

1. Remove side branches larger than ½ inch
2. Branches to be four (4) inches in diameter maximum size
3. Larger branches and trunks will be the home owners responsibility
4. Each house will be allowed 2 stacks at the yards edge. The stacks may be no larger than six (6) foot maximum length, three (3) foot maximum pile height, and three (3) foot pile width.
5. Special arrangements may be made for larger quantities. Contact City Hall for arrangements
6. Place tree branches going the same direction along the yards edge
